**Definition of a carer: "A carer is someone who provides unpaid help and support to family or friends who are ill, disabled or who just need some extra support."**

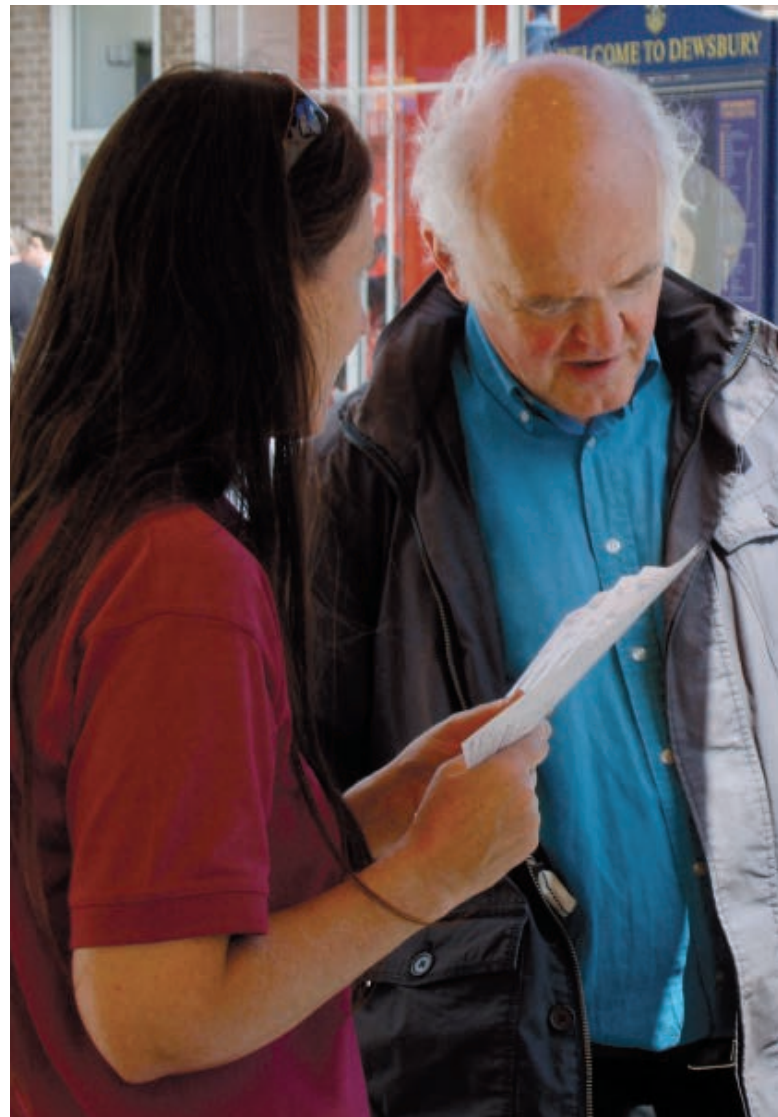
