The Government has been working over the past few years to improve the lives of people with mental health needs, learning disability and autism. The vision is that everybody should be treated with dignity and respect by health and care services.



Although things are starting to improve for some people this is not always the case and for some people admitted to Assessment and Treatment Units they are still not always given the same rights as everyone else.

The Government has some ideas of how they can work to improve this and are asking questions about how to make people's lives better.
