## **Organisational issue**

Getting a response when asking for support

- Very long delays in allocation of workers to undertake assessments..an increasingly significant issue
- No continuity of staff back to the old days of having to tell your story to someone new every time you request a service
- Lack of response and ongoing communication while you are waiting for something to happen
